




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

OTIM is proud to be Official Supporter Sponsor of Italy at Expo2020, Dubai

he "making of" this astonishing masterpiece is a perfect marriage between ancient beauty, sophisticated technologies (digitalization and 3D print) and high-skilled handicraft. The **OTIM team** has been at the **forefront of the project** from the very beginning and has taken care of handling, forwarding and the installation of this incredible artwork.

With approximately 6 metres in height and 2 metres in width, the 1:1 replica of Michelangelo's David started its journey from Florence to the next EXPO in Dubai. First steps were completed in Florence in mid April, with the involvement of 12 people, two trucks and a crane for securing, handling, laying down,

packing and loading operations. We took 6-8 hours to harness and secure the art piece, to lift it into horizontal position and get ready to start packing. This was performed in strict silence to allow the "listening" of the art piece to various solicitations. Not even the restorer who assembled the 3D printed pieces and refined them with resins and marble powder was aware of all possible reactions.

DIGITALTWIN

Challenging was the fact that the replica was assembled and refined in a tiny art-workshop where the narrow aisle was just a little bit larger than David's dimensions. In addition, the statue had to be transported out of the art-workshop from an ancient portal in a very narrow street in the historical

centre of Florence and loaded onto a truck with a small crane. **Packing operations** were also tough and complex with finding the right balance between 2 different and unavoidable needs: **highly securing the statue** whilst carefully **preserving its surfaces and integrity**. If you consider that this art piece is a hollow body, you can easily understand how fragile it is.

The statue was laid on a wooden base, protected by polystyrene templates and polyphrene sheets which were placed below, above and around the head, chest and legs, held together with alumimium / steel bars. Working during the night made the entire operation even more spectacular. The journey of David then

The 1:1 replica of Michelangelo's David is a project jointly promoted by the Italian General Commissioner's Office for Expo 2020 Dubai, the Galleria dell'Accademia Museum of Florence and the Ministry of Culture in partnership with the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering at the University of Florence.

continued to the airport where the masterpiece was boarded onto a 747 Cargo aircraft, reaching Dubai on April 21st at 5.15 am. Due to the strong collaboration between our team, our local agent, airport authorities, Police and Custom officers, the artwork could be cleared and released in one hour.

We delivered and installed the replica of David on April 22nd, supported by our local partner **Masstrans Freight LLC** whose specialist team ensured that on-site procedures ran perfectly. The delivery location was a noisy building site working 24/7. Once uncrated and unpacked, the next challenge was to lift the statue into a horizontal position.

This was carried out by crossing the 1st floor of the pavilion located at 5 metres above the ground and using 5 hoists fixed on a 10 metre high beam before finally easing it into a very tight cylinder surrounded by a colonnade. Again **coordination**, **patience** and **silence** were 3 crucial factors.

Finally on April 27th 2021, at Italy Pavilion @Expo2020 Dubai, the 1:1 replica of Michelangelo's David statue was unveiled in the presence of the Ministers of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of Italy and UAE. It has been a long and challenging journey and it is still a long way to The Grand Opening Ceremony of the Expo2020 Dubai.

We can definitely say that the model was among the most unusual parcels O.T.I.M. has handled in the past year and for sure the most challenging ever recorded!! antiquities based on previous shipments in which it cooperated with the Syrian Museum.

The packing plan was drawn up by **Darwish Logistics**, approved by experts from the two museums, based on the crating of pine wooden boxes, using PV foam, adhesive and linen ropes and cotton papers. The packaging process already started under the daily online monitoring by experts from both museums. After finishing the packing we will move the boxes via a specific truck escorted with private security company to Beirut airport via Syrian border to be shipped by air to China.

There are many details that we


